

## Permission to View EIV Information

EIV (Enterprise Income Verification) is a web-based computer system containing employment, unemployment and Social Security benefit information for individuals participating in HUD's rental assistance programs.

The HUD Form-9887, signed by each adult household member at Move-In and at every Annual Recertification, gives your permission for management to use EIV as HUD requires, to obtain income information and employment history for each household member.

EIV data must be kept confidential. However, in order to complete your household's Annual Recertification, we may need to share your EIV information with other individuals. Without your consent, we will need to show and discuss EIV income information with every adult household member separately.

I give my permission for my EIV income data to be viewed and/or discussed with any adult of my choice during the Annual Recertification interview process.

If a tenant requests a copy of his/her own EIV data, the tenant will sign and date a statement indicating that s/he has requested and received such a copy. This statement will be kept in the tenant file. Once printed data is provided to the tenant, management cannot be responsible for the confidentiality of that information.
